His promises cover every aspect of life — spirit, soul and body. We've been given His nature, power for healing,



news of deliverance just as they did, yet they didn't join their faith with the Word. Instead, what they heard didn't affect them deeply, for they doubted. For those of us who believe, faith activates the promise and we experience the realm of confident rest!"

Every one of them had the same promises from God. Everyone saw the same giants. Everyone saw the same fruit in the land. What made Joshua and Caleb have such a different report when they returned? It was their perspective founded in faith.

When faith in God's Word dominates our perspective, we

of failing because of the giants in the land. For two of them, possessing God's promise was in their sights. For the majority, their fear of failing was too great. The report of the majority caused Israel's perspective to melt in fear.

Jesus is our greatest example of this. Facing the cross, Jesus kept before Him the joy of knowing sin's grip on mankind would be destroyed through Him. That strengthened Him to endure even the cross and suffering of

separation from the Father. He became sin for us.

Because his heart was focused on the joy of knowing that you would be his, he endured the agony of the cross and conquered its humiliation, and now sits exalted at the right hand of the throne of God! (Hebrews 12:2 TPT).

Jesus kept His eyes on the results of His endurance — our total deliverance.

Even during His ministry, Jesus endured the pressures arrayed against Him. Hebrews 5:8–9 in *The Mirror* translation gives powerful insight of how He did it.

Acquainted with sonship he was in the habit of hearing from above; what he heard distanced him from the effect of what he had suffered. By his perfect hearing he forever freed mankind to hear what he had heard.

His habit was to hear. And He has given us the ability to hear what He heard. Hearing from above will put a protective distance between us and the pressures arrayed against us.

What are we listening to? While this certainly includes the voices around us, this is mostly referring to the voice within us. Our inner dialog can be a source of strength, or a stumbling block to our faith.

The continual commentary in our minds will either feed

our faith or our fear. Having our point of view established by God's perspective sets the tone for His plans to prevail.

This is evident in Caleb's first words to Moses when he returned, "Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses, and said, 'Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it" (Numbers 13:30).

Caleb spoke with confidence and authority as he stood up to the majority.

The others allowed the threats of the giants to become like blinders in their minds.



But the men who had gone up with him said, "We are not able to go up against the people, for they are stronger than we" (v. 31).

Fear distorted their perspective of who they really were— God's people. Fear caused them to see themselves like grasshoppers in their own eyes.

Perspective changes more than the way we see. It changes the flow of God's greatness within us. But when our thoughts align with His, we have more than enough power to prevail in any situation.

So, what about you? Are you in the habit of having bad reports change your perspective? Has the pressure around you stifled the power within you? Or do you see yourself standing strong in God's Word and your ability to conquer what you're facing?

I'm encouraging you to examine yourself. Give your attention to what is shaping your perspective. When you find yourself focused on the problem, stop your inner dialogue, and flip the script to the voice of faith
