
INSIGHTS

God values us like a king guards his treasure

kept in a protected place due to its extraordinary value.

hroughout its history, not only has Israel experienced supernatural interventions but also more than its share of desperate situations. From their captivity in Egypt, to wandering in the desert forty years, to finally possessing the land of Canaan that God had promised them. There were epic victories and horrific defeats.

For example, under Joshua's leadership the nation flourished. As Joshua followed God's instructions, Israel possessed one region after another, thereby establishing dominance in the land. As long as Israel identified with God, they thrived.

But after Joshua died, the nation strayed from God's ways and in the process lost their identity as His special people. They wandered so far from Him that during Gideon's days the Midianites attacked and pillaged Israel's settlements forcing them to seek protection in caves for seven years.

God used Gideon, listed among the heroes of faith in Hebrews 11, to bring deliverance to this terrorized nation. Yet, when Gideon first makes his appearance, he is no hero. He is terrified, hiding, and hoping to thresh just enough grain to feed his family.

It's upon this backdrop that God initiates a metamorphosis.

And the Angel of the Lord appeared to him [Gideon] and said to him, The Lord is with you, you mighty man of [fearless] courage (Judges 6:12 AMPC).

How can that be? Gideon did not appear mighty, fearless, or courageous. Instead, he oozed weakness and fear. He perceived his

family as the weakest among his tribe, and himself as the most insignificant member of the family.

Gideon identified with the confidence-killing mindset that destroyed his faith in God. He let fear and family define him. But God burst into the doubt-filled atmosphere to redefine him. Gideon was about to be given a new identity - mighty man of courage. A warrior.

Although God saw Gideon's desperation, He had a different point of view. When God spoke, Gideon's eyes opened to his true identity. Once Gideon saw from God's perspective, he let go of his old way of thinking and identified with God's new truth.

Like Gideon, the way you see yourself defines you. Your mindset literally determines the boundary around the territory of your life that you cannot cross. This is what the war waged against you is all about - how you see yourself and the boundaries that contain you. Will you embrace the person God says you are, or will you allow fear and circumstances to define you?

Jesus prayed for His disciples about this very thing. This is John's account of Jesus' prayer:

I'm not asking that you take them out of the world But that you guard them from the Evil One. They are no more defined by the world than I am defined by the world (John 17:15 MSG).

Because you belong to Christ the world does not define you.

- Your past does not define you.
- Your behavior does not define you.
- Your failures do not define you.
- Your family does not define you.
- Your bad decisions do not define you.
- Your feelings do not define you.
- Your circumstances do not define you.
- Current ideologies do not define you.

Like Gideon, today, God Himself redefines you.

Everything His Word says about us reveals our new identity in Christ.

- You are righteous.
- You are healed.
- You are a child of the Most-High God.
- You are an overcomer.
- You are a conqueror.
- You are valued and valuable.

- You are a new creature.
- You are chosen by God.
- You are His special people.

Notice how the Apostle Peter defines you:

> But you are God's chosen treasure—priests who are kings, a spiritual "nation" set apart as God's devoted ones. He called you out of darkness to experience his marvelous light, and now he claims you as his very own. He did this so that you would broadcast his glorious wonders throughout the world (1 Peter 2:9 TPT).

A footnote for this passage in The Passion translation says:

> The Hebrew word is ségulla, which means "a special treasure" (possession). It is used to describe "guarded wealth," indicating the placement of the king's jewels, treasures, etc., in a safe, protected place because of their extraordinary value. God says that each believer is a priest and king, his unique and special treasure of great importance—a treasure above all other treasures. (This is taken from Exodus 19:5-6 and Malachi 3:17).

God calls you His treasure. You are valued even if others don't value you—God does!




I learned this principle when selling an automobile: value is determined by what someone's willing to pay for it, not what you think it's worth.

How we see ourselves makes all the difference.




Don't lie to one another. You're done with that old life. It's like a filthy set of ill-fitting clothes you've stripped off and put in the fire. Now you're dressed in a new wardrobe. Every item of your new way of life is custommade by the Creator, with his label on it. All the old fashions are now obsolete. Words like Jewish and non-Jewish, religious and irreligious, insider and outsider, uncivilized and uncouth, slave and free, mean nothing. From now on everyone is defined by Christ, everyone is included in Christ (Colossians 3:9-11 MSG).

Make the decision to be done with the world's ways. Refuse to be identified and defined by the spirit of the world, the pain of your past, today's culture, or the current ideology. You are defined by Christ.

You are a member of the Body of Christ. This indicates that while at one point Jesus was the one body that was born of God, now you are born of God and His anointing defines you.

You are the body that carries and contains the anointing.

the Lord stepped out of Heaven into this realm to reach one man. Everything changed that day. God was there for Gideon. Today, He is here for you!


