

Like the eagle, our renewal is actually ongoing also. We maintain our strength and vitality by consistently meditating in God's Word, and then applying it. Our fresh fellowship with the Holy Spirit keeps the youthful awe and wonder of God's greatness alive.

In David's days little may have been known about the birds' habits. We now know that over time in every eagle's life it becomes slower in flight. Its feathers can even begin to give off whistling warning sounds which can alert its prey of an attack. This decline of its feathers over time will slow its ability to be the powerful hunter of its youth.

Time takes its toll, and the aging eagle must take needed and concerted action to renew and regain its strength.

A long-time minister and friend of mine, Col Stringer, has spent many years actively involved in the field of wildlife, both in conservation as well as research in the lives of these birds.

In his book, *On Eagles Wings*, Col describes this time in the eagle's life:

Eventually, after days of

preening, plucking, honing, grinding, and washing, the eagle is ready to return to the outside world. He spreads his huge wings, and then alights from the mountain peaks, a new bird. Its youth has been renewed. Once again, the eagle becomes a powerful, dangerous bird to contend with. A bird to strike fear in the heart of every serpent. The king of the sky moves off to survey his domain, with new feathers for soaring, new beak for slashing and a new set of talons for grasping prey. He soars, aloft, rolling, swooping, and diving at incredible speeds of 100 miles an hour. A bird with new life, new strength, and a new joy for living!

He has regrown the damaged feathers, re-honed his beak and talons to lethal sharpness again. He is again the master of his domain.

The picture God gives us for renewal is profound. While we will always face issues that may dull our sharpness and slow our responses or progress, we are not without hope. We are not finished just because we are in a difficult season.

Isaiah 40:31 NKJV says, "But those who wait on the LORD Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint."

Renewing comes as we "wait on the Lord." The point is not to simply endure as time passes or wait for Him to finally give some attention to our situation. By digging into this verse, the process of renewal becomes clearer.


The word "wait" means to bind together by twisting, braiding or entwining. In wrapping ourselves around the Lord and His Word we also allow Him to wrap Himself around us. This results in renewing our strength. To renew is more than only regaining what has waned. This word indicates an actual exchange!

The greatest exchange of all is when we gave Him our sin, and He gave us His righteousness. His exchange gives us what we don't deserve.

As a part of this exchange, we have access to all the grace God has provided.

His grace has provided:

- Courage in exchange for discouragement
- Hope for the future in exchange for hopelessness
- Healing in exchange for sickness
- Access to His presence in exchange for distance and isolation
- Confidence in exchange for condemnation





he most majestic bird in the sky is the eagle. While there are a variety of eagles, the Golden Eagle is one of the largest.

These birds have powerful hooked beaks for tearing flesh from their prey, strong legs, powerful talons, and keen eyesight.

The Golden Eagle is a very large raptor, 26" to 40" in length. Its wings are broad, and the wingspan is 5'11" to 7'8". The wingspan of the Golden Eagle is the fifth largest among living eagle species.

Scripture uses the eagle as an

example of a vital process for every one of us.

Who satisfies your mouth with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle's (Psalm 103:5 NKJV).

The process is for our times of renewal. The picture God gives us is full of rich revelation. This particular bird molts gradually as temperatures warm, lasting several months each year. Molting usually decreases in winter. Feathers on the head, neck, back, and scapulars

can be replaced annually. With large feathers of the wing and tail, molt begins with the innermost feathers and proceeds outwards in a straightforward manner known as "descendant" molt. This regular maintenance guarantees that the eagle will remain at its maximum performance levels.
